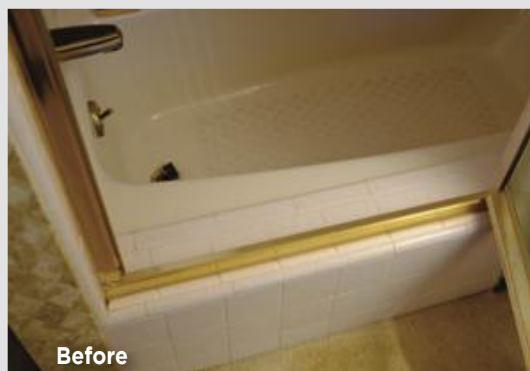


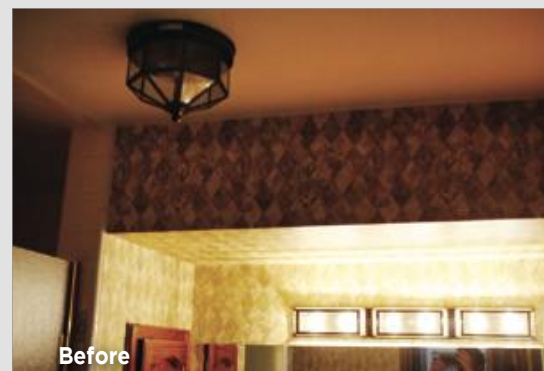

Premium hall bath remodel

This hall bath consisted of a walled in shower tub, with a tiled wall separating the shower from the vanity area. A large soffit over the vanity, dark and heavily patterned wall paper, and insufficient lighting, made this room uninviting and small. Removing the top half of the wall separating the shower and the vanity and replacing it with clear glass, removing the shower tub and the soffit, stripping the wall paper, smoothing out the walls, as well as installing new lighting made a dramatic change in the appearance and perceived size of this hall bath. During deconstruction of the back shower wall, an unused space between the hall bath and the staircase behind it appeared, which was promptly incorporated into the shower area to allow for a bench and a shelf.

Excellent finishes and details

1. Shower bench and shelf, created by extending shower into available empty wall space.
2. Large format glass door and glass panel between vanity and shower.
3. Ceramic tile on all shower surfaces, with matching stack tile details and 2' x 2' floor tile.
4. Glossy subway ceramic tile backsplash in a herringbone pattern.
5. Sconces on both sides of the mirror.
6. Designer mirror.
7. Chrome faucet matching the shower trim and the sconces.
8. Platinum gray quartz countertops with matching side splashes.
9. White Shaker style cabinetry.
10. Semi-gloss paint on smooth textured walls.
